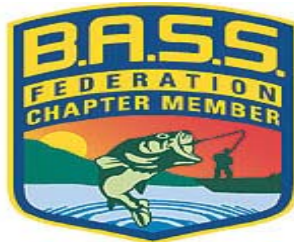

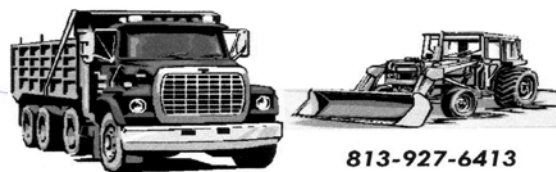
Just kidding guys - thanks for supporting the federation.
